

The pattern is presented on scale 1:1, that is: if printed without scaling, it will work for loops of 76cm length, as described in the paper. The outer dashed lines are cutting lines (but after stitching the fabric may be trimmed further along the outer contour of zigzag stitch). The short dashed lines are sewing lines (sew "right sides together", so the stitching will be on the inside of the finished project, upper panels connect to upper panels, lower to lower, and colors must match. Use a simple zig-zag stitch for the short seam lines. Note the left-turning and right-turning instructions from Figure 3 in the paper, it is easy to make mistakes here. The long seamlines, marked are topstitched. This file can be sent directly to a sublimation printer of 61cm wide such as an Epson SC-F500 (for a smaller printer, editing may be needed).
